Client Engagement Tour on SDV Conveyor System



A big thank you to Michael Walt and Nicholas Tyas for facilitating the tour, and to the Hargreaves Industrial Services site team for the excellent condition of the plant. It still looks brand new after handling over one million tonnes!

Sustainability wise, the million tonnes has removed over 50,000 lorry movements and 900,000 miles from the public highway. This has saved >400 tonnes of CO₂, which is equivalent to the planting of more than 2,500 trees. We are very proud to have made a small contribution to the UK's journey towards net zero.

DB Cargo Team partners with Environment Agency to enhance flood management and wildlife conservation in Oxford



Recently, DB Cargo teamed up with the Environment Agency to help support the Oxford Flood Alleviation Scheme. The Environment Agency is currently working to reduce flood risk in Oxford.

The accompanied site included the undertaking of eDNA surveys by the EA's consultant ecologists. This included a conservation project to provide access to fenced-off areas of the site. After successfully removing and reinstating the fence lines, this allowed the conservation project access to the areas of site left for wildlife.

The team even found traces of Crested Newts, a rare and protected Newt in the UK. Thank you to the team at DB Cargo for your efforts.

S&B Utilities begin Severn Trent Water Sewage Treatment works

Severn Trent Water is undertaking a significant project involving mechanical installation work by S&B Utilities. The project, which began on October 23, 2024, aims to install a new tertiary solids removal plant and a TSR recirculation pump station. The project involves Ductile Iron pipes, bracketry, pressure testing, and confined space working. The project aims to enhance wastewater treatment capabilities and contribute to environmental practices and infrastructure development. The team is focused on completing the project by November 15, 2024.
