## **New Site Services Contract to Commence in** December



We are pleased to announce that our new site operations contract with Enfinium will commence at the start of December. HIS will support the day-to-day operations of the brand-new energy from waste facility, based in West Yorkshire. This includes crane operation, tipping hall duties, and ash handling. We are confident that this partnership will enhance operational efficiency and contribute to a sustainable future.

The facility will process up to 410,000 tonnes of residual waste and use it to generate 49MW (gross) of renewable baseload electricity per annum. This is enough energy to power more than 100.000 UK homes.

#### Reward & Recognition: Darren Tong Honored for Exemplary Safety Actions



Darren Tong, Industrial Cleaner at Staythorpe Power Station, received a reward and recognition from HIS for proactive safety actions. Darren has been recognised by RWE, the station owners and operators.

Staythorpe is a gas-fired combined-cycle gas turbine power plant that began commercial operation towards the end of 2010. It has a gross capacity up to 1,850MW – enough to cover the energy needs of around 2.8 million homes.

Darren reported a leak on a pump, informed the control room, and made sure no one entered the area until operation staff arrived. Darren's actions serve as an exemplary model for his colleagues, reinforcing the culture of safety that is vital in the workplace.
